THE GLAMORGANNWG CODE OF CONDUCT

- ~ we understand the need for freedom of speech providing this is based on truth, love and non-judgment
- ~ we understand the need for freedom of health choices, and the importance of working in harmony with the body and not fighting against it
- ~ we understand the need for tolerance, respect and acceptance of all within the principles of Natural Law
- ~ we are a co-operative where we are all happy to help each other in any way we can
- ~ we have running costs that are met by regular donations which we are grateful to all family trusts for contributing towards
- ~ we are dedicated to building a better future for generations to come
- ~ what we do not tolerate: bullying, preaching of beliefs or opinion, condescending others, fear-mongering, pushing of mainstream narrative, ridicule for beliefs and opinion, or any attempt to destabilise and divide our community and any behaviour that is contrary to Natural Law

These are core principles of our Nation and are reflected in our Constitution.
