Dear Valued Farmer,

We are writing to you for ourselves and on behalf of our small team who intend to farm self-sustainably, keen to return to a natural 'indigenous' way of living in harmony with the land.

As such, we are looking to buy 15-30 acres of land to establish a private community farm in the old Glamorgan area of South Wales (preferably close to Caerphilly).

We understand that British farming is under threat due to new government policies involving inheritance tax burdens and the transition to new environmental land management schemes, and that these pressures place strain on family-run farms. If you could see your way clear to selling us a said portion of your land we believe that this would be mutually beneficial, on several levels:-

- **Finance to Navigate the New Challenges:** By selling 15-30 acres, you can unlock immediate funds to reinvest in your farm for any adaptations required for the new 2026 payment schemes (such as the Sustainable Farming Incentive or Environmental Land Management schemes). We are open to discussion regarding price and payment methods.
- Continued Agricultural Legacy: Our vision ensures your land continues to be used for agriculture, unlike development projects or renewable energy, which are destroying British farming.
- **Use of Unproductive Land:** Our project includes the rewilding of land that is less productive for farming, such as woodland and land that we can utilise towards our biodiversity goals.
- **No Competition:** Our farm produce will be exclusively available to our private membership, meaning we will not compete with your existing markets. Our community aims to source supplies from local farms like yours until we become established, and ongoing purchase of produce beyond our remit.
- **Collaboration:** We are keen to collaborate on joint ventures if you wish to, such as educational programs, or integrating your expertise into our initiatives, and we would like to form mutually beneficial agreements.

- **Supporting Local Economic Growth:** Our project will provide volunteering opportunities and attract visitors to our retreat where we will promote locally-sourced produce at our gatherings.
- **Positive Environmental Impact:** Our lifestyle farm will prioritize biodiversity, soil health, and the health and well-being of the land, so you can take pride in knowing your land will play a role in addressing current issues.

We are looking to start this project as soon as possible as we already have investment and donation pledges, and will shortly be moving from our rented accommodation so we have no other restrictions. We are therefore in a position to offer a straightforward purchase, and we are also open to renting land with a view to purchase at a future time, or while a sale goes through.
